A word from Father Kirby:

We are Christ the King, a Catholic University Parish. What does that mean? We were established with the special mission to serve the University of Montana students, faculty and staff. This mission has expanded to include many faithful throughout Missoula, bringing about a lively and diverse parish with families from all walks of life. This being the case, we still have a particular call to serve the University.

The University of Montana is called to give young people the truth. They study the sciences that they might know the world and how it all works. Yet, we know we're left stranded, for knowing how the world works means nothing without knowing how it ought to work. It is only when we meet Jesus Christ that we see what could be, what ought to be. Without him, we wade in the abyss of truth without meaning.
