Greetings Christ the King Parishioners,

The five years I spent at St. John Vianney seminary were amazing and helped me to know priesthood was my vocation. The Church confirmed my call, Bishop Thomas ordained me, and sent me to Butte. I loved everything about my time in Butte- you will hear plenty about that- but after three years, Bishop Vetter entrusted me to you, the good parishioners of Christ the King University parish! I'm ready to serve you with all my energy and creativity, to bring Christ to you, and, with your help, to recreate the University of Montana and this town in God's image!

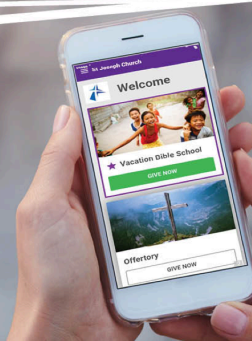

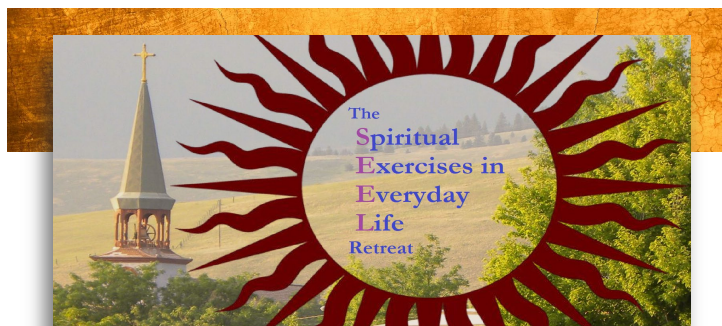
