## Who is Father Gasper Mavumilio Kyara?



I am a religious priest of the Holy Spirit Fathers – ALCP. I was born in Moshi – Kilimanjaro Tanzania in March 17, 1970, the seventh child of nine children of Paul and Monica Kyara. I was raised in a Catholic family and educated in primary and secondary schools. In 1997, I began my higher studies at the Kibosho Philosophical Senior Seminary. Later, I earned a Bachelor Degree in Sacred Theology at the Salvatorian Institute of Theology Morogoro-Tanzania. After my ordination in 2004, my first assignment was as an Assistant Priest at Rauya Parish and as a Chaplain at Rauya Theological College. I later served at Generalate Office - Moshi. In 2006, I went for further studies in Rome at the Salesian Pontifical University where, in 2008, I earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Education. In 2010, I received a Master Degree (Licentiate) in Sciences of Education; later, in 2012, I was awarded a Doctorate degree Ph.D in Sciences of Education. From 2012-2017, I was a lecturer at Jordan University College – Tanzania and held various roles including Head of Department and Dean of Faculty of Education. Later, I was sent to Mission – U.S from 2018 through October 2019 to serve as Staff Chaplain at Geisinger Holy Spirit Hospital in the Diocese Harrisburg - Pennsylvania. Currently, I am a servant at Christ the King Parish – Missoula!

### **Who am I? “I AM because WE ARE” ... We are and so, I am!**

African philosophy of life says: “I am because we are, and we are, therefore, I am” to underline the argument that our life is relational and communal that works for the community of life without borders; a community life that cares for and seeks the wellbeing of all through ‘life giving presence’.

We are, and so, I am — ‘life giving presence’ constitutes the basic — perhaps the reason of my being at a particular time and place to fulfill what Jesus said: “I came that they might have life and have it more abundantly” (Jn 10:10).

As we reflect our “life giving presence” as Christians; we turn our gaze toward our baptismal role that the baptized are sent. Pope Francis exhorts every baptized person to revive missionary awareness and commitment by giving a fresh evangelical impulse to reach others as Jesus commanded: “Go, then, to all peoples everywhere and make them my disciples.” (Mt.28:19)

These last words of Jesus continue to open my mind in a new horizon toward a new community. Christ the King Parish is a community of life and love where each and every one learns to love and be loved; to respect and be respected; to appreciate and practice faith as well as human dignity of each person from the youngest to the oldest, because we all are created in His image and likeness. We are bestowed the highest dignity of being called “the children of God!”

Our hope, therefore, is that as “children of God” we are able to embody our ‘life giving presence,’ that can exemplify through services and caring one another as family and people of God. We may live with little faith and even without true love, but we cannot live without hope.

Let us pray that we may live with hope and receive our life mission with joy and gratitude. Let’s turn our hearts toward the love of God and be open with mindfulness and caring compassion bearing and forgiving one another. And above all put on love, that is, the bond of perfection (Col 3:12ff). “I am your servant, because, you are”. **Happy New Year, God bless all!**

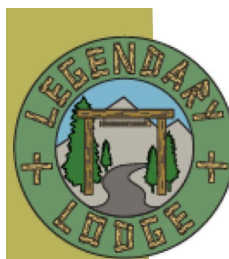
