

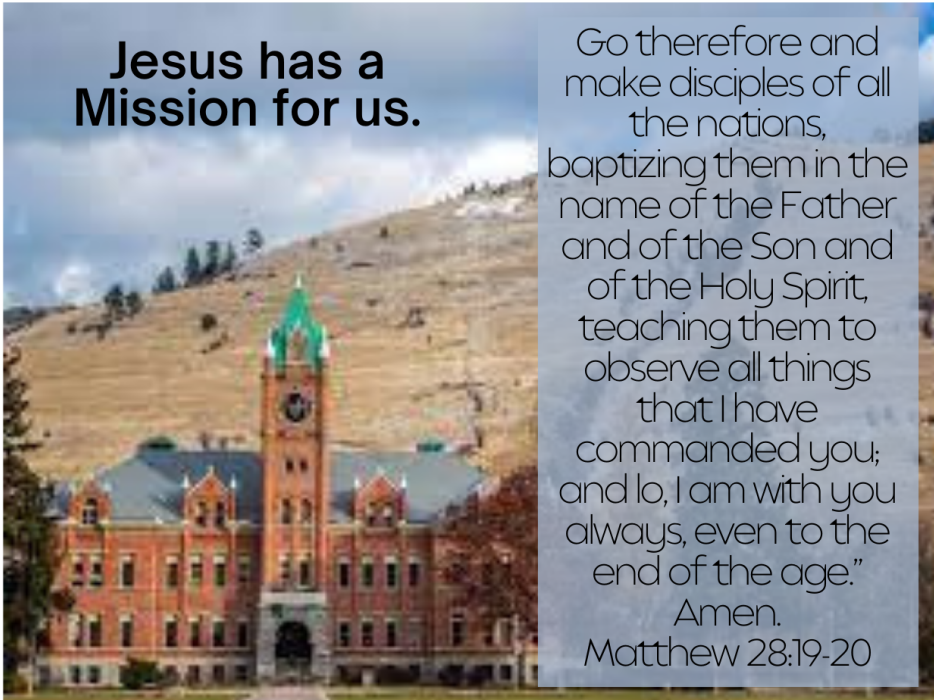

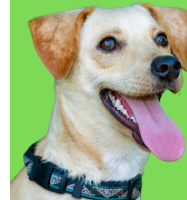

The Spiritual Exercises in Everyday Life (SEEL) is a retreat designed for busy people like you. Even people with families and who work full time can have this profoundly transformative experience because it takes place within the midst of your daily life.

The aim of the Spiritual Exercises is the attainment of spiritual freedom; the power to act out of the promptings of the Holy Spirit in the deepest, truest core of your being – to act ultimately out of love. The heart of the retreat is daily prayer using Scripture and other materials provided by your retreat director. Weekly spiritual direction meetings and monthly SEEL Retreat Evenings are integral the retreat as well.

The SEEL retreat is for mature adult Christians living in western Montana. There's no cost to participate. Here is what some past retreatants are saying:
