BECOMING THE HANDS AND FEET OF JESUS A REFLECTION FROM OUR INTERN JAMES SEMLING

For the last academic year, Christ the King, has been sending out brave college students and parishioners to encounter the poor of Missoula twice a week. On these encounters, the only agenda is to love the people we meet and share the light of Christ.

On one of these outings, because there were a few options about we should go, we prayed asking the Holy Spirit to guide us. One of our FOCUS missionaries, Jessica Figoni, exclaimed, "Let's go to Greenough Park Bridge!"

Upon reaching the site, we encountered a man and his dog laying under the bridge. We cautiously approached and introduced ourselves. As the tension started to break, he happened to have recognized Jessica from a street walk earlier in the year. Our new friend Michael opened up to us that he had been coughing up blood for the last 24 hours. We tried to get him to stand up, but he was too weak. Michael did not want to go to the hospital and get the treatment he needed because the hospital did not allow dogs. After some quick discernment, we decided we could hold onto the dog for this man while he went to the hospital and that God would provide.

Fr. Kirby generously allowed the dog to stay at the rectory and Michael's life was saved at Saint Patrick's Hospital. Two weeks later, the dog, Nikki, was reunited with Michael.

The miracle continued when speaking to Michael's father, Michael Senior. He was so impressed by the act of charity and the providence surrounding his son's life being saved

he asked us "What religion are you guys? Because whatever it is, I'm joining." Not even a week later he invited the local priest of Hot Springs Montana over to his house to learn about our faith.
