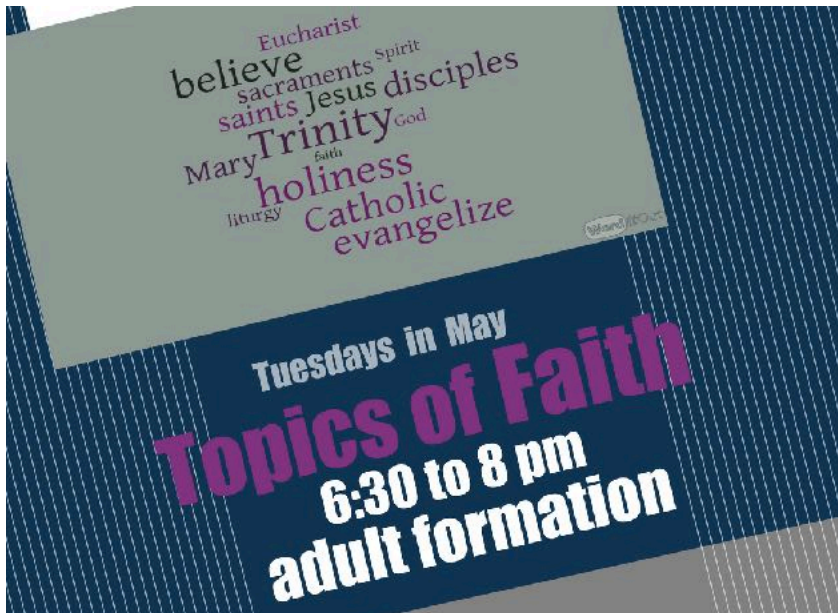

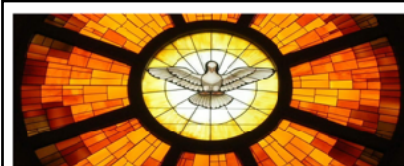

Montana Jewish Project

The MJP is an all-volunteer non-profit organization based in Helena, Montana.

The Knight's of Columbus Council 13022 is sponsoring a fundraiser for MJP. Their mission is to reacquire Temple Emanu-El from the Helena Catholic Diocese supported and promoted by Bishop Austin Vetter of Helena to establish in it a statewide center for Jewish life and learning. The Bishop agreed to sell these properties for \$925,000, which is well below market value. The Montana Jewish Project must have the entirety of the money raised by June 30, 2022.
