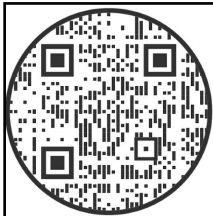

Parents' Night Out!

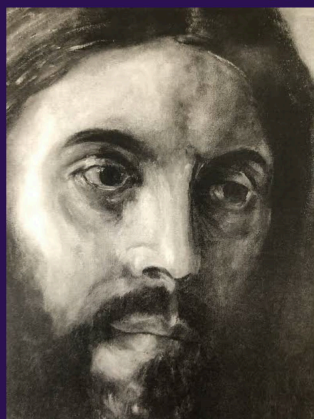
Saturday, Dec. 10, 2-9 PM
