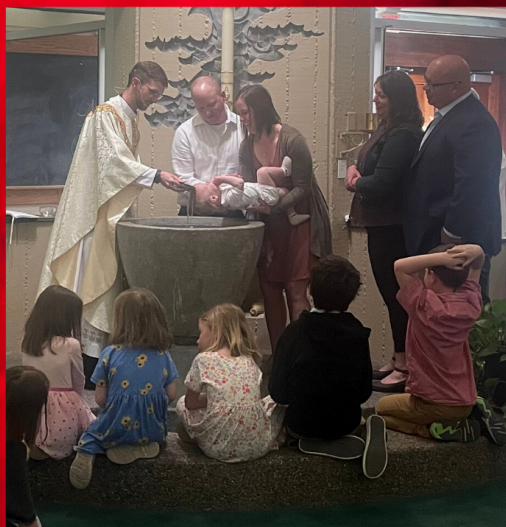

As many of you may know, we, at Christ the King are considering some major facility updates and improvements. To assure that we address the financial feasibility and the desire for all the projects, we have invited Petrus Development, a firm specializing in guiding professional capital campaigns, to lead a campaign planning process to assess critical factors and help plan the best approach for success in this effort.

As part of the process, Petrus is interviewing various members of our community to better understand the history, vision, and viability of such projects by asking critical questions to better gauge the satisfaction level of a possible capital campaign. Currently, we are only in the survey and exploration phase of the process.

## Montana Jewish Project

The MJP is an all-volunteer non-profit organization based in Helena, Montana.



For the last 40 years, a stone building on Ewing Street has housed offices for the Roman Catholic Diocese of Helena. But when it first opened in 1891, it was Temple Emanu-El, the first Jewish synagogue in Montana.

The Knights of Columbus believes in the spiritual power of interfaith communities and supports Bishop Vetter and the Montana Jewish Project (MJP).

The MJP is an all-volunteer non-profit organization based in Helena, Montana. Their mission is to reacquire Temple Emanu-El from the Helena Catholic Diocese supported and promoted by Bishop Austin Vetter of Helena to establish in it a statewide center for Jewish life and learning. MJP will coordinate with Montana's Rabbis and congregation leaders to offer programming, events, speakers and education for the state's Jewish individuals and communities working across the state for interfaith dialogue and learning. Their goal is not only to build acceptance for Jews in Montana, but also to work across religious institutions to fulfill the key Jewish principle of Tikkun Olam ("repairing the world.")

MJP desires to buy the historic synagogue, Temple Emanu-El, at 515 N. Ewing, the yard to the south, the six parking spots behind the building, and a house at 512 N. Rodney St. The bishop agreed to sell these properties for \$925,000, which is well below market value. The Montana Jewish Project must have the entirety of the money raised by June 30, 2022.
