## ***A Note From Fr. Jeff***

### ***Happy Easter!***



As I write this note, the images of the fire at the Cathedral of Notre Dame are vivid in my mind. It is a powerful image for Holy Week and what we believe and celebrate at Easter: that death and destruction are not the end. Life and love triumph!

Put yourself in the shoes, or sandals, of the disciples of Jesus. They had been following Jesus for three years. They had seen him cure the sick, walk on water, raise the dead. But more importantly, they had called him friend. Jesus also invited them to see God, not as a distant judge, but as an intimate father, a daddy.

But then the tide of public opinion rose against him. He is arrested, tortured, put through a mockery of a trial, and then put to death, a horrendous death on the cross. They are frightened and scared; their world has been turned upside down. They don't know what to do, or where to turn. They are lost.

But the story doesn't end there. On the third day, Jesus rose from the dead. Death and sin are defeated; love and life conquer all.

We truly are Jesus' disciples. We also encounter death and destruction. Where in your life have you felt lost and hopeless? Know that Jesus is walking with you, even when all seems dark. Allow the resurrection to enter your life this Easter; light, life and love conquer all.

## Fr. Cody's Corner



Nothing is more foundational to our faith than the Resurrection of Jesus. Sometimes we forget how profound and important this event is for both our faith and the entirety of what we believe. Let me put it this way: without the Resurrection, we would not be Christians. Without the Resurrection, we cannot have life, forgiveness from sins, or the hope of something to come. Without the Resurrection, we have no reason to come here on Sunday. The Resurrection of Jesus is foundational to our faith.

Understanding the importance of the Resurrection has two main aspects: the fact that Jesus rose from the dead and its importance for us. The fact of Jesus rising from the dead has been receiving increasing speculation over the last few decades. Amidst this speculation we have many sources of evidence that attest to Jesus' resurrection: eye witness accounts through the Scriptures, the Shroud of Turin, the finding of the True Cross and the burial site of Jesus. Yet, only through faith do we gain absolute certainty of Jesus' Resurrection since through faith we come to know the one who rose from the dead.

The second to last line of the Creed summarizes the second aspect: I look forward to the resurrection from the dead. Stating that I hope to be resurrected is not the same as believing that Jesus rose from the dead. Our goal is to come to believe in Jesus' resurrection. That comes through prayer, through encountering the Risen Lord, through coming to know him personally. We cannot know someone who is not physically present, unless they are present in another way. Thus through prayer and meditation we come to know that Jesus rose from the dead and we come to know how his resurrection shapes our faith and hope.

I encourage you to take some time today to pray. Take some time to remember what we celebrate. And, most importantly, to take some time to thank God that Jesus rose from the dead and gave us new life.

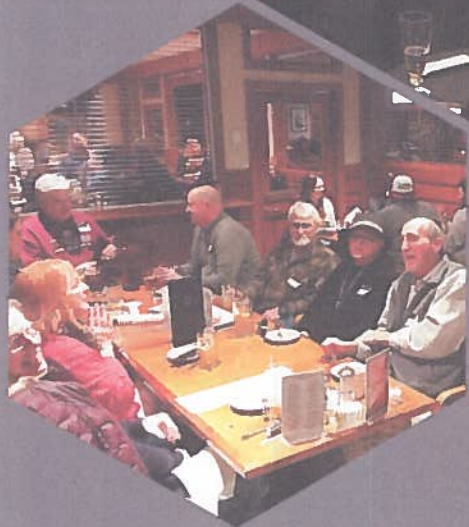
