Fr. Cody's Corner



Lost in the richness of the green pine trees; small flies circling about in the summer sun; bright light streaming through the pine branches; a gurgling brook churning in the distance. This is God's country. This is also where the noise of the modern world vanishes and the small whispering silence becomes audible. This is why I hike, and this is why I have created "Mass on the Mountains." Following from some of the greats like St. Pier Giorgio Frassati and St. Pope John Paul II, Mass on the Mountains aims to bring our religion beyond the four walls of our parish building. Many don't realize this, but even the Jerusalem Temple, when it stood in all its glory, was adorned with nature imagery. The Jewish people understood that the Temple stood as a microcosm of the universe; a place where the beauty of creation joins with the divine. We are no different. Our churches are meant to mirror that same idea: the created world and our faith become one. Venturing out into God's cathedral opens up the experience of our faith to a global perspective, joins us with God's own creative powers, and reminds us that our religion is meant to go out. Instead, we are called to bring our faith into the entire world; to recognize that evangelization is not a program but a process. A process of bringing our faith and the joy of what we celebrate with us everywhere we go. I hike to encounter God; we celebrate Mass on these hikes to remind us of God's ever presence. Here we are found.

- If you're interested in the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist for your child, and he/she has participated in at least one year of Sunday School, either at Christ the King or at your previous parish if you're new to CTK, we will begin with a parent orientation meeting on Nov. 6 at 6:30 pm. Please register on the Sacraments page of the parish website.



- If you're interested in the Sacrament of Confirmation at for your high school youth and he/she has participated in at least a year of Youth Ministry, either at Christ the King or at your previous parish if you're new to CTK, please get in touch with Derek Wherley, Youth Ministry Leader at dwherley@ctkmsla.org, as soon as possible.
- Adults in need of Confirmation, contact Patti Cassidy in the parish office.

- If you're interested in the Sacrament of Marriage, please contact Fr. Jeff Fleming or Fr. Cody Williams in the parish office at least 6 months in advance of your hoped-for wedding date.
- If you're interested in the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick for yourself, a family member or friend, please contact Fr. Jeff or Fr. Cody in the parish office.
- If you or someone you know is interested in learning more about the Catholic Tradition or would like to become Catholic, please contact Patti Cassidy in the parish office. The formal process designed for entering into full communion with the Catholic Church is called Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults or RCIA.



- With the exception of Anointing of the Sick, preparation for each Sacrament at Christ the King may begin with Alpha. Those who come to Alpha will find a welcoming community of people who strive to be real and authentic and allow you to be the same. We've found, over time, that when we allow people to be themselves and ask their questions, focus on building relationships and rely on the Holy Spirit, lives are transformed.
