Divided into 16 teams, they travel across the U.S. for nine months to share the Gospel with young people and their families. Since 1981, NET teams have led over 30,000 retreats and ministered to more than 1.8 million young Catholics.

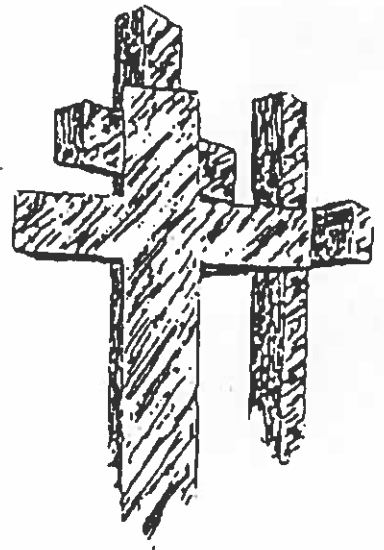

I would like to take this opportunity to share with you some exciting news from our parish. Our newly formed Pastoral Council has 'hit the ground running.' They are actively involved in a process to plan for our parish's future by utilizing a dynamic and agile process. Watch as the first couple of projects begin, including a social media project to share with the larger community the heart of our parish as well as a regularly scheduled Anointing of the Sick Mass.

In March, 75 parishioners participated in the Diocesan Listening Sessions. The first two questions looked at the hopes and needs of our parish. We are listening. Some areas we are focusing on include communications and attracting and empowering lay ministry.


