

What does it mean to be a Newman Center?

The "Newman Movement" in the United States began in 1883 at the University of Wisconsin, and was focused on helping Catholics live their faith on campus amid perceived anti-Catholicism. This led to the first Newman Club being established at the University of Pennsylvania in 1893. From the turn of the century through World War II, these clubs became increasingly popular across the country, though they

were usually characterized by a hostile attitude towards the academic world. After Vatican II, Newman Centers evolved to become lynch pins in Catholic Campus Ministry, known to be welcoming spaces of ecumenical and interfaith dialogue, and rallying posts for social justice efforts. They improved relationships with the academic community and are recognized for their "remarkable diversity of legitimate styles and approaches" to match "unique situations at particular colleges and universities."¹
