MEN'S GROUP



Meet Liz at Le Peak (on campus in the Cornerstore) for a time of discipleship, friends, and coffee! We will meet every Monday at 8 am.





What is the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)?

The rite of Christian initiation is designed for adults who, after hearing the mystery of Christ proclaimed, consciously and freely seek the living God and enter the way of faith and conversion as the Holy Spirit opens their hearts. By God's help they will be strengthened spiritually during their preparation and at the proper time will receive the sacraments fully. (RCIA #1)

What is an RCIA Sponsor?

The job of the sponsor is to get to know the candidate well enough to be able to assist the candidate on the journey. The sponsor is not a catechist or an "expert" in the faith, but is faithful and knows what it takes to remain faithful. As an "older sibling," the sponsor is instrumental in assisting the candidate to gain a sure footing and move confidently forward. Before the Rite of Acceptance, the sponsor assists the candidate with beginning his or her spiritual life and nurturing the first seeds of Christian faith. The sponsor will assist the candidate in calling upon God in prayer, and will introduce the candidate to other Christians in the faith community (see RCIA 42).
