Genesis Bible Study Outline:

- **Session 1: Creation and the Garden (Genesis 1-3)**
 - Adam and Eve: what were they like? How were they different from us?
 - The Fall and Original Sin: what was the original sin? What were the effects, physical, spiritual, psychological.
 - God's plan of redemption: What does he promise?
- **Session 2: Evolution and Christianity- Do Faith and Science contradict?**
 - Six Days of Creation, is it literal?
 - Does evolution preclude faith?
 - The three questions science cannot answer
 - Evolution, Adam and Eve, and the brain
- **Session 3: Pre-history- Cain and Abel, Noah, and the Tower of Babel. (Genesis 4-11)**
 - What are we to think of these stories?
 - Where do they come from, did they actually happen chronologically?
- **Session 4: The call of Abraham: Psychoanalysis: balance of known and unknown**
 - Abraham, was he a good man? Grace in the OT

- **Session 5: Abraham's life:**
 - The Sacrifice of Isaac
 - Life of Isaac, Jacob and Esau
